

# ST BARTHOLOMEW'S CHURCH, LOSTWITHIEL MEMORIAL INSCRIPTIONS IN THE CHURCHYARD

## INDEX

1. Surnames are in alphabetical order and in date order within the same surname.
2. For the purpose of identifying the location of memorials, the churchyard is divided into the following sections:-

### Section

- A** West Boundary Wall on the South Side of the Church.
- B** External South Wall of the Church or close thereto.
- C** South Boundary Wall by the Entrance from Fore Street.
- D** South Boundary Wall From the Headstones under the Yew Tree by the South Porch to the East Boundary Wall.
- E** East Boundary Wall or close thereto.
- F** External East Wall of the Church.
- G** External North Wall of the Church or close thereto.
- H** West Boundary Wall on the North Side of the Church.

and each memorial is given an identification number within the section in which it is located.

3. The churchyard was closed to future burials on 31 December 1856 and the first burial in the new Restormel Road Cemetery took place on 12 February 1857. That cemetery was closed to future burials in February 1962.

4. In 1961 the grave stones and headstones were removed from their original locations and placed against the retaining walls of the churchyard.

3. In 1961 the grave stones and headstones were removed from their original locations and placed against the retaining walls of the churchyard.

4. Comments within brackets and in italic script are those of the compiler of this record.

5. St Bartholomew's Church is situated in a conservation area and is a Grade I listed building (List entry no: 1327333) under the Planning (Listed Buildings and Conservation Areas) Act 1990, as amended, for its special architectural or historic interest. A 'List entry no' in brackets at the end of a description of a memorial denotes that the memorial is listed as a Grade II 'building' under the same Act.

### Section A - West External Boundary Wall, South Side

- A1 In Memory of NICHOLAS HUGO who departed this Life the 8<sup>th</sup> day of Nov<sup>r</sup> 1796. Aged 63 years.  
Also of MARY, the Widow of Nicholas Hugo, who departed this Life the 26<sup>th</sup> day of February 1805.  
Aged 63 years.
- A2 In Memory of NANCY TREFFRY, the Wife of WM. BECKERLEG, who died on the 11<sup>th</sup> day of February 1827. Aged 21 years.  
Also of MARY WESTLAKE BECKERLEG, Infant Daughter of the above who died on the 30<sup>th</sup> of March 1829. Aged 2 years.  
*(The top part of this memorial is broken off and is now lying at the base of the stone.)*
- A3 Sacred to the Memory of SARAH COPPIN SANDERS who departed this Life the 21<sup>st</sup> of April 1815.  
Aged 12 years.  
"Death soon may call you here  
Although that you are in your prime  
Before another Sun doth shine  
Therefore thyself prepare."
- A4 Here lieth the body of THOMAS ROBARTS who was buried the 21<sup>st</sup> May 1784. Aged 33 years.  
"A pale consumption gave the fatal blow  
The Stroke was certain but the effect was slow  
With pain death found me sore oppress  
Pity'd my Sighs and kindly gave me rest."

 "Surviving Friend remember well  
 His mortal Constitution  
 And with redoubted Diligence  
 Prepare for Dissolution."
- A6 Here Lieth the Remains of MARY the wife of JOHN NICHOLSON, who Departed this life January the 28 1801. Aged 22 years.
- A7 In Memory of CATHERINE STATTON who died the 22nd of May 1833. Aged 39 years.  
 "Alas dear Mortal here you lie  
 Free from distres and pain  
 Till God's loud trumpet rends the sky  
 And makes your dust again."
- A8 In Memory of THOMAS DANIEL who died the 27<sup>th</sup> day of October 1799. Aged 38 years.  
 Also his Son, JOHN DANIEL, who died the 18<sup>th</sup> day of Jan<sup>y</sup> 1816. Aged 26 years.
- A9 In Memory of ANN BESWARICK, the daughter of THOMAS & MARY BESWARICK of this Borough, who died the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of December 1818. Aged 2 years.
- A10 Here lieth the Body of DOROTHY, the wife of John WESTLAKE, who was buried Feb<sup>y</sup> 26 1757. Aged 74 years.  
 Also MARY SAMWELL daughter of Dorothy and John Westlake And wife of WILLIAM SAMWELL of Pill in the parish of Lanlivery, who departed this life the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of October 1779. Aged 63 years.
- A11 Here lies the Body of BERNARD WESTLAKE, the Son of HUMPHREY WESTLAKE and ELIZ., his Wife, who departed this Life the 11<sup>th</sup> day of March 1763. Aged 5 years.  
 "Weep not for me my parents dear.  
 Lament me not nor shed a tear.  
 My joys are great with my redeemer sweet  
 In heaven again I hope that we shall all meet.  
 Where we with angels then shall sing.  
 The praises of our God and King."  
*(List entry no: 1138028)*
- A12 Here lies the Body of ELIZ. the daughter of HUMPHRY and ELIZ. WESTLAKE, who Departed this life the 21<sup>st</sup> day of May 1764. Aged 8 years.  
 "Father farewell mother y<sup>e</sup> same  
 I'm gone to dust from whence I came."  
*(List entry no: 1138028)*
- A13 In Memory of JOHN HAMBLEY, Late of this Borough, who departed this life on the 7 day of March 1806. Aged 49 years.  
 Also of SUSANNA, Wife of the above, who departed this life on the 21 day of Jan 1833. Aged 77 years.  
 And SUSANNA, Their Daughter, who departed this Life on the 9 day of Jan<sup>y</sup> 1809. Aged 22 years.
- A14 To the Memory of JOHN HARPER who departed this life on the 12 day of April 1796. Aged 86 years.
- A15 In Memory of ELIZ<sup>TH</sup> ROGERS who departed this Life on the 17<sup>th</sup> day of June 1828. Aged 49 years.

### Section B - South External Wall of the Church or close thereto.

*(On the wall above the sepulchral vaults which are under the fourth window of the South Aisle)*  
  
*(This memorial is on the south wall above the two sepulchral vaults which are under the fourth window of the south aisle and to which the memorial refers.)*

On the outside of the Church in the wall between the south porch and the angle of the west wall and below the window of the fourth window of the south aisle there were two arches, formed out of very roughly cut and irregularly shaped Pentewan stone. In the centre, the ends of these arches rested on a pier of the same stone while the ends furthest from the centre touched the wall of the porch on one side and the corner buttress on the other and the arches were built flush with the wall of the Church. On 14 July 1890 the wall was opened and two sepulchral vaults were discovered within the thickness of the wall, the only entrance being from the outside.

Each vault was two feet wide from front to back : the one nearest the porch is six feet three inches long, the other is six feet ten inches long. They are one foot seven inches high at each end, to the spring of the arch, and two feet two inches high in the centre of the arch : The back, top, and sides, were plastered with rough mortar. Human bones were found in both : those in the tomb next the porch rested on a rough flooring of flat stones, those in the other seemed to have been simply laid

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on the earth, the bones in this vault, from the few that were left, seemed to be those of a man of large stature. There were no signs of a coffin, or remains of wood, in either.

The remains found here were probably those of Robert de Cardinan, who died between the years 1224 and 1234, and Isolda Fjtz-william, his wife, who died some years before her husband.

Those tombs were closed with flat stones, 2 August, 1890.



- B2 A chest tomb now covered by a slate slab inscribed 'WILLIAM TAPRELL Died 1652' which replaced the original slate slab. The original slate slab, which was described in 1891 as 'much broken', was ornamented, with an engraved and scrolled border of flowers and leaves, within which was inscribed:

'Here lieth the body of WILLIAM TAPRELL, often Mayor of this Borough of .... was buried the .... of .....

"All flesh is grass, whose verdure quietly fades,  
The brightest day soon terminates in shades,  
Of worldly grandeur vain is the whole story,

*(The pieces of slate on the ledge of the fourth window in the south wall are believed to be part of the original slate slab on this tomb. See Church Memorial Ch. 28. in the Church.) (On the right of the entrance to the South Porch.)*

- H1 Here lieth the Body of SARAH, the Wife of CHARLES PHILP, who was buried March 26<sup>th</sup> 1772. Aged 63 years.  
"Husband farewell. Children the same.  
Hope in Heaven to meet again."
- H2 Here lieth the bodey of MAREY PHILP, the daughter of CHARLES & SARAH PHILP, who was buried 22<sup>nd</sup> Octr 1739. (*Broken*) *Found in the loft of a nearby house in 2006 and placed beside the gravestone of the child's mother.*
- H3 EW 1764
- H4 In Memory of JOAN, the Wife of JOHN JAMES, who was buried November the 2<sup>nd</sup> 1750. Aged 61.
- H5 Here lieth the Body of CUTHBERT GREENBERY who was buried the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of January 1709.
- H6 To the Memory of JOSEPH ELLYOTT of St Winnow who was buried the 8<sup>th</sup> day of September 1717. (*Part of left-hand side broken off.*) (*List entry no: 1327336*)
- H7 To the Memory of MARY TEAGE who died ye 15<sup>th</sup> day of May 1780 in ye 50<sup>th</sup> year of her Age. (*Top right hand corner broken off.*)
- H8 Here lieth the Body of MARY CLARK, who Departed this Life May the 3<sup>rd</sup> 1770. Aged 69.  
  
"Time cutts me down  
My Glass is run  
Death gives the blow  
And I am gone." (*List entry no: 1327335*)
- H9 Here lieth the body of NICHOLAS the Son of NICHOLAS and GRACE STRONG who was buried March ye 22 1757. Aged 29 years.  
"A pious life he always lead,  
While he on earth remain'd,  
no doubt but that this harmless youth  
true Bliss hath now obtain'd."
- H10 Here lieth the body of JANE wife of JAMES RALPH who was buried March the 29 1750. Aged 55.
- H11 Here lieth the Body of JOHN ELLIOTT SPILLER who was Buried the 23 day of June 1746. Aged 5 years.  
"His Spirit doth Heaven inherit". (*List entry no: 1138010*)
- H12, 13 and 14. Three broken pieces of slate headstone with unintelligible wording.
- H15 Top of a slate headstone with 5 lines of wording.
- H16 In Memory of MARY, the Wife of JOSEPH DODD, who was buried October the 7<sup>th</sup> 1757. Aged 61 years.
